Priest Lake Marathon FAQ's

How do I get to the event?

Hills Resort is located on the West Side of Priest Lake Idaho. From Spokane WA, follow US Highway 2 North to Newport WA and continue on US Highway 2 to Priest River, Idaho. At the stoplight in Priest River, turn North on Highway 57. The great thing is that it only goes North! There are mile markers along the highway from Priest River, counting the way to the lake. This is the part where you enjoy the view – watch out for Moose. Do not turn off Hwy 57 until you pass Mile Marker 28. Just past MM 28, turn Right on Luby Bay Rd. Follow Luby Bay Rd until you reach the stop sign. At the stop sign a wonderful Priest Lake Volunteer will direct you to turn right to go to the parking area– about 150' south of the intersection. You don't need to tip the parking volunteer- just smile and say thank you! You're at Priest Lake!

Where do I go after I park?

Race day packet pickup **AND** chip pickup will be at the lobby of Hills Resort. You should still be smiling because the race is almost ready to go!

Where is the starting line?

The start and finish line is at the Main Entry to Hills Resort. Please– NO PARKING ON LAKESHORE ROAD.

What will the weather be like?

Variable conditions can exist. We are in an alpine environment in North Idaho. Warmer temperatures of 70F are possible, and cooler temperatures around 55F with showers are possible. Please check our local forecast a few days prior to the event to plan your clothing needs.

Are there mile markers on the course?

Yes

What kind of aid stations will be on the course?

FULL– Water/Gatorade at MM #'s 1.5, 3, 5, 7, 9, 12, 14, 17, 19, 22.5, 25, Gel at MM14

HALF– Water/Gatorade at MM #'s 1.5, 3, 6.2, 8, 10, 12

Are there toilets on the course? Yes

FULL– Starting Line, MM 5, MM10, MM 14, MM 21

HALF– Starting Line, MM 3, MM 8

What is available at the finish line area?

Recovery food and drinks will be provided to all participants to include fresh fruit, bread, bagels, juice and soup. Hill's Resort will be providing a beer garden to participants over 21. Here you will really be smiling because– you are at Priest Lake, and you just finished the First Annual Priest Lake Marathon or Half Marathon!

What are the awards categories?

Overall Male 1st-3rd, Overall Female 1st-3rd, Age Groups 1st-3rd– 14-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+
